

*Turn an old bottle cap into a Christmas greeting!*

**You will need:**

- Pilot silver marker – extra fine
- Purple card blank
- Scraps of lime green, white and purple paper
- Bottle cap
- Green wire scroll
- Green thread
- Self-adhesive gems
- Snowflake paper punches
- Double-sided adhesive tape
- Foam self-adhesive pads
- Glue dots
- PVA adhesive

**Step 1**

Tear a 4.5cm square of lime green paper and use double-sided adhesive tape to attach it to the corner of the blank purple card.

**Step 2**

Using a Pilot silver marker, scribble parallel lines on scraps of white and lime green paper. Cut large and small snowflake motifs with paper punches.

**Step 3**

Tear a 3.5cm square of scribbled white paper and attach it to the lime green square. Add silver dots around the lime green edge.

**Step 4**

Cut a circle of purple paper and add a Christmas greeting with the silver marker. Attach the circle to a bottle cap then fix the cap to the card with foam pads, trapping a green wire scroll beneath.

**Step 5**

Attach snowflakes using glue dots and then place self-adhesive gems in the centres of the snowflakes and the bottle cap. Add a tie of green threads, using a small dab of PVA adhesive to secure the knot.
