

## CHRISTMAS CRAFT PROJECT

# Peace on Earth

### You will need:

- ★ Pilot Silver marker (fine point)
- ★ Pilot Brown G-TEC-C4 pen
- ★ Pale blue card blank
- ★ Sheet of pale blue card
- ★ Scraps of lime green, pale blue and white card
- ★ Green craft wire
- ★ Silver stretchy cord
- ★ Circle and hole punch
- ★ PVA adhesive
- ★ Glue dots
- ★ Foam self-adhesive pads

### CHRISTMAS CARD

#### Step 1

Punch three circles from scraps of pale blue card and write a word in each, using the brown G-TEC-C4 pen. Decorate a scrap of lime green card with lines, using the silver marker.

#### Step 2

With the hole punch, make four spots of green card. Using PVA, attach the 'peace on earth' discs and green spots in a row along the top of the card. Add a silver striped green trim at the bottom of the card.

#### Step 3

Draw the dove and wings onto white card with a silver marker. Cut them out and glue the wings in position. Attach a curl of wire to the reverse of the dove, using glue dots, then attach the dove to the card. Add three small leaves and silver spots.

### CHRISTMAS GIFTWRAP

#### Step 1

Fold a piece of pale blue card to fit around the card, overlapping at the front with a wavy cut. Trim this edge with a piece of silver striped green card.

#### Step 2

Using the brown G-TECC-C4 pen, write 'season's greetings' onto two circles of pale blue card and add them to the striped trim. Make a small layered tag, thread it onto silver stretchy cord and tie it around.
