

Silver Bells

You will need:

- ★ Pilot Silver marker (medium and fine point)
- ★ Pilot Turquoise G-TEC-C4 pen
- ★ Turquoise card blank
- ★ Turquoise tissue paper
- ★ Scraps of pale blue and lime green card
- ★ Silver wire scroll
- ★ Turquoise gems
- ★ Green stretchy thread
- ★ Small silver rings
- ★ Holly and small hole punch
- ★ PVA adhesive
- ★ Foam self-adhesive pad
- ★ Glue dots
- ★ Glue stick

CHRISTMAS CARD

Step 1

Punch small holes in two torn strips of lime green card and attach them at each side of the card blank, using PVA adhesive. Add silver pen dots and little turquoise 'stitches'. Add a piece of striped tissue at top and bottom.

Step 2

Using a silver marker, decorate scraps of pale blue card with scribbles and stripes and cut out two bell shapes. Cut a third bell shape, in undecorated pale blue card. Trim away the edge of the scribbled bell shape, as shown on the template and glue it onto the undecorated bell. Punch small holes in the striped bell shape.

Step 3

Attach a silver wire scroll to the card using a foam self-adhesive pad. Add the bells, also using foam pads to attach. Add a punched holly spring and a turquoise gem, using glue dots to attach.

TIP

When attaching wire scrolls, make them long enough so that the 'unseen' part is easy to fix onto the card.

CHRISTMAS GIFTWRAP

Step 1

Using the silver marker (medium point) make stripes on turquoise tissue paper and wrap the gift, securing the edges invisibly with glue stick.

Step 2

Tie small silver rings onto green stretchy thread and tie it around the package. Cut out a striped silver bell motif and trim it with a punched holly motif and a turquoise gem, then attach to the gift.
