

## HALLOWEEN CRAFT PROJECT

# Spooky Mobile

### You will need:

- ★ Pilot silver marker – extra fine
- ★ Pilot silver marker (extra fine)
- ★ Pilot gold marker (extra fine)
- ★ Pilot white marker (extra fine)
- ★ Pilot Fineliner (Black)
- ★ Orange card
- ★ Brown card
- ★ Black card
- ★ White card
  
- ★ Gold wire 20 gauge
- ★ Pliers
- ★ Fishing wire or fine thread
- ★ Tape
- ★ PVA glue
- ★ Scissors
- ★ Wiggly eyes of various sizes (largest is 2cm across)
- ★ White pencil
- ★ Scrap paper



### General Instructions

#### Step 1

Trace or photocopy the large pumpkin pattern on to orange card and cut around the outline of the shape.

#### Step 2

Place the pumpkin shape on to scrap paper and outline the edge of the pumpkin with a Pilot Gold marker. Add detail as per the template.

#### Step 3

Cut out the mouth by starting with a cut in the centre, and then with small scissors cutting around the shape. Some adult supervision maybe required. Alternatively leave the mouth uncut and colour in with Pilot Fineliner.

#### Step 4

Attach two wiggly eyes of differing sizes with glue. Now outline the mouth using silver marker, add a nose and eyebrows above the wiggly eyes.

#### Step 5

Secure a length of fishing wire or thread to the back of the pumpkin with tape. Cut out another pumpkin shape from black card and glue to the back of the orange pumpkin, sandwiching the wire in between the two shapes.



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### Owl

Trace or photocopy the owl pattern on to brown mottled card and cut out the shape. Cut or punch two circles from white card (3.7cm or 1 1/2in diameter) and two from black card (1cm or 7/16in diameter). Sometimes kids art packs have ready cut circles which are ideal to use. Glue the white circles to the owl, then the black circles on top of the white, for eyes. Outline the owl with Pilot silver marker adding eyebrows, beak and detail also. Cut another owl shape and attach a length of fishing wire sandwiching it in between the shapes as per pumpkin instructions.

### Bat

Trace or photocopy the bat pattern on to black card. When tracing around a shape on to black card it is best to use white pencil. Cut out the shape. Add detail with Pilot silver marker to the bats wings and attach two wiggly eyes. A Pilot White marker was used for the two fangs and silver for the mouth. Cut another bat shape and attach a length of fishing wire sandwiching it in between the shapes as per pumpkin instructions.

### Ghost

Trace or photocopy the ghost pattern on to white card and cut out the shape. Add detail with Pilot silver marker and attach two wiggly eyes. Cut another ghost shape and attach a length of fishing wire sandwiching it in between the shapes as per pumpkin instructions.

#### *Time saver tip*

Here two of each shape were cut to hide the wire and sandwich it between the two pieces of card however this is optional and just one of each shape could be made with the wire taped to the back of each shape.

Cut lengths of gold wire approx 25cm, 11cm and 17cm long. With the pliers twist the ends of the 25cm and 11cm lengths round to make small loops at the ends. Make a loop in the middle of each piece and now thread the 17cm length in each central loop and twist the wire. Secure the shapes by tying the fishing wire to each end, adjusting the heights as necessary.



The pumpkin and owl are attached to the same wire as they are similar weights, if you place a bat and a pumpkin then it will be lopsided because the pumpkin will be heavier than the bat.

#### *Tip*

If you are making lots of each shape it is best to make a template from scrap card – a cereal packet is ideal.
